## CALL FOR PAPERS

The **Fall 2013 Technical Meeting of the Western States Section of the Combustion Institute** will be held at **Colorado State University** in **Fort Collins, Colorado** on **October 7-8, 2013**. Technical papers are solicited on all aspects of combustion including chemical kinetics; soot and PAH; heterogeneous combustion; alternative fuels and engine combustion; combustion diagnostics; supersonic combustion; and innovative and emerging concepts in combustion. Papers may cover a broad range of focus, from fundamental combustion phenomena to practical applications of combustion technology. Papers from industrial organizations are strongly encouraged. Please note that presentation of a paper at this meeting does not constitute archival publication.

## DEADLINES

Prospective authors should submit an abstract of 100 to 200 words online at <http://www.eecl.colostate.edu/combustioninstitute> by Monday, **July 1, 2013**. Decisions on acceptance will be transmitted to the authors by **Friday, July 19** by the WSS/CI Program Chair, Prof. Judi Steciak of the University of Idaho. Full papers of at least 5 pages in length are to be submitted electronically and will be distributed to all registrants on a CD-ROM or USB drive. Presentation of papers is contingent upon having an electronic copy of the accepted paper received by **August 25, 2013**.

## REGISTRATION FEE

A CD-ROM or USB drive containing the conference proceedings is included in the cost of meeting registration. The fee for advance registration is \$240 (members of the Combustion Institute), \$280 (non-members), \$65 (student members with suitable identification), \$75 (student non-members). The advance registration deadline is **September 7, 2013** after which the fees are \$280/\$320/\$75/\$85. (Forty dollars of the differential charged for non-members (\$10 for students) will be applied toward membership in the Combustion Institute. Registration includes refreshment breaks, and a reception on the evening of October 7. ## STUDENT TRAVEL AWARDS

Please indicate if a student will be presenting the paper. The Western States Section of the Combustion Institute awards a travel stipend of up to \$150 to each non-local student (travel distance > 50 miles) presenting a paper. Student presenters must apply for awards no later than **September 7, 2013** to be considered for an award. Please send student applications to Prof. Anthony Marchese at [marchese@colostate.edu](mailto:marchese@colostate.edu). The application should include the title of the presentation, the student's mailing address, and a statement from the faculty advisor verifying that the student is registered at his/her home institution and a statement from the faculty advisor (or senior lab scientist) indicating whether the faculty advisor will also be attending the meeting. To receive full consideration for the travel award, it is strongly encouraged that faculty advisors accompany the student presenter to the meeting.
